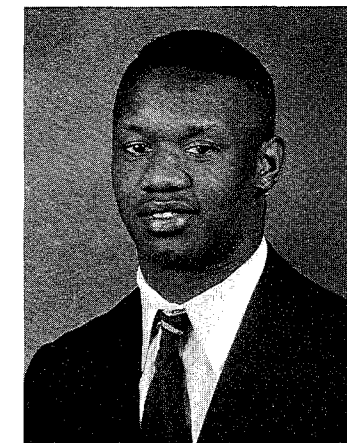
### *E. Bell Reid III*
