



# The Bell Came First

**Wait on the Lord: be of good courage,  
and he shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the Lord.**

**Psalm 27:13-14**

*Seeing God in Everything*

One of the special joys of my adolescent years was listening to my parents talk about important events that took place in their lives. From childhood to adulthood, from dating to getting married, my mom and dad shared these treasured occurrences—both the joys and challenges.

I can recall my mother talking about the day that she and my father first met. She laughed as she said, "*I could not stand your father when I first met him.*" But my father was determined, and his persistence paid off. My parents were married for 36 years, before my father went home to be with the Lord.

Of all the stories they shared, there is one that inspires me to this day. I was fascinated as my parents revealed that they were a part of the Great Migration. During the Great Migration, which occurred from 1916 to 1970, more than 6 million African Americans moved from the South to the North in search of better lives.

As newlyweds in 1948, my parents had to adjust to life in the big city. They also had to adjust to living with less, for my father was the only one working. Being many miles away from home, they could not go to "momma's house" for a home-cooked meal, when their cupboard was bare. Instead, it was solely up to them to make ends meet.

One day, while sitting in their one-bedroom apartment, my father surprised my mother by giving her a small gift box. When she opened the box she saw that it contained a doorbell. My mother was puzzled as to why my father would give her such an item. My father declared that they would not always live in a tiny apartment. He vowed that, one day, they would have a house to go with the doorbell.

Holding on to the idea that owning a home was in their future, my mother put the doorbell away for safe keeping. It took a while, but in 1975, 27 years later, my father kept the promise that he had made to his bride; my family and I moved into our house. Although the house was considered a "fixer-upper," nevertheless, it was ours. When we moved into our new home, one of the first things my father did was install the doorbell. To this day, the sound that resonates from this doorbell is a reminder to me that, sometimes, we just have to wait for some blessings.

I'm sure my mother had her moments of doubt, but she waited patiently. As Christians, we strive to trust and wait on the Lord, but waiting can be difficult—unbelief can creep in. We may be tempted to give up on a dream or desire. We may even try to move ahead of God, and attempt to force an outcome. But the Lord knows when the time is right; He knows when we are ready.

Although it may take days, months or years, to achieve our goals or receive our blessings, let us make good use of our waiting period by being of good courage and trusting in God.

*Dear Father, we are grateful that You do not give us what we want, when we want it, but rather what we need, when we need it, for You know what is best for us.*
