

When Johan was two months old, he was diagnosed with meningitis which caused him to lose his hearing. Trying to adjust to being hearing impaired, Johan learned ASL (American Sign Language) and uses it to communicate.

According to his mother, Johan has been dancing since he was a small child and has always has loved dancing. He started choreographing routines in elementary school and had his first talent show with his sister and two cousins appearing as guests to show their support. Johan has done tap dance, praise dance, modern jazz, hip-hop, waltz and step dancing. He teaches dance to three groups in Champaign: House Arrest 2, National Dance Team, Inc. and Dream Team Chapter 2. The teams he is involved with are his heart!

Johan has appeared on WCIA Channel 3 News several times in the past two years. He has been frequently asked how he became a dancer when he can not hear. He answer is simple: "That's the gift I received from my mother and from GOD!" One thing that Johan knows for sure is that he is not, will not, and refuses to let anyone discourage him from using the gift he has been blessed with...the gift that sets him apart from other people, makes him different, unique and special in the arena of dance.
