# Initial Short Term Year to Goals

- **Infrastructure**

- **Continue to develop and define our governance, decision making and communications model**
- **Continue to meet with Stakeholders to identify needs and shared priorities**
- **Continue to look for new ways of building and developing partnerships (formally and informally)**
- **Continue to explore trauma and trust building as guiding principles**

- **Service Delivery**

- **Hire a Clinical Coordinator and Intake Specialist**
- **Begin to conduct some baseline evaluation**
- **Begin a small pilot with youth and families (plan pilot)**
  - **Develop some shared intake and assessment processes**
  - **Recruit, hire, and train staff who will be delivering services to youth and families in our community**
  - **Formalize partnerships with organizations and individuals in the pilot**

# Youth and Family Short Term Goals

## • Youth Guided Goals

- To continue to train and build the youth advisory board
- Work with other youth serving agencies to form a Network of Youth/and Youth Providers
- Create a strategic plan for youth leadership
- Ensure that youth are involved in every working group, committee, and task force as full participants

## • Family Driven Goals

- Continue to work to develop the Family Advisory Board and the P3 Network
- Develop a mentoring and coaching model
  - ▶ Learn more about regional and national parent leadership and involvement efforts
  - ▶ Ensure that parents are involved in every working group, committee, and task force, as full participants

# **EVALUATION Short Term Goals**

- **Document ACCESS effort and community/systems change.**
  - **Though a Data-Informed Process and a commitment to Continuous Quality Improvement**
- **Generate ideas/question to pursue in local evaluation.**
- **Assist with development of survey of front line providers/responders and agency leaders to assess current:**
  - **System of Care principles in practice**
  - **Local policies**
  - **Interagency coordination**
- **Assist with data interpretation and plans to share information gathered.**

# Committees, Workgroups, and Task Force

- **Committee:** is a body that will work together to identify goals, priorities, partners, and sometimes become directly engaged in the work in core SOC areas of focus.  
Supported by staff (required by SAMSHA)
- **Working Group**-will come together to address a need or complete a task for a limited period of time.
- **Task Forces:** Interdisciplinary Groups organized to identify needs, wishes, best practices, and challenges in important focal areas :
  - Juvenile Justice
  - Resource
  - Child Welfare
  - Schools
