- Elementary schools → segregated
- Integration of Dorms? but could still swim in public pools
- Bethel housed UofI students
- Project 500, 1968
someone yelled 500/ but 565 or so.
- Mr. Mayes → kept beehives + sugar to feed them in his soyer.
- Burch Village → the projects (now Douglass Square)
50s → 60s
- The Champaign Courier (no longer in Existence)
+ Illinois Times → stopped running in 70s
black News paper.
- Reputation of Univ → concerning treatment of its black athletes.
- black-owner establishments → church night clubs
- Several barber-shops on First Street
- occupations — laborer rail road barber Teaching
- Bethel was considered high-church in the community
- Employment at UIUC → Rantoul Air force B NOT big reputation of hiring black peop (≈ 60s).
- Champaign-Urbana → seemed progress as compared to others.

- music → in churches
- Drummer Band
- Cover Park
- Douglass Park
⇒ probably biggest influence the community center
- Library Branch, opened
- McDuff!
- Migration pattern = from Springfield, North, Chicago
- Black people lived in Urbana
- 3 community [Ch, U, North End]
- Did not grow up w/ concept of North End
- Abernathy → North of Eureka
- North End Reunion = 2nd week August
↓ probably since 1993 (at least)
- his mother → degree in Math from UofI
- church → social network
- fallacy → not all blacks lived in North End (Mrs Suggs)
- churches + schools dominant inst.
