SCHOOL - COMMUNITY RELATIONS

Education Equity Excellence Committee Policy

The Board shall establish an Education Equity Excellence Committee (EEE). The EEE shall be comprised of District staff and a diverse cross section of the District community. The purpose of the EEE is to review and discuss the following equity areas:

- Academic progress of regular education, special education, gifted, AP/Honors, Academic Alternative Academy and alternative students
- Attendance rates
- Discipline rates
- Graduation rates

For at least the 2009-2010 school year, the EEE shall be facilitated by a third party familiar with community and District issues. The EEE shall establish task forces on the above equity areas as deemed necessary. The Superintendent shall provide mid-year and end of the year public report on the above equity areas to the EEE, including data disaggregated by race/ethnicity and socioeconcomic status.

The District will prepare Administrative Procedures to implement this Policy.
