ACKNOWLEDGMENTS

*Law*

The Black Community of Champaign-Urbana has become aware that they can have some control over their environment. As a result, the need for organizing information about themselves and their relationship to Champaign-Urbana has grown in importance. Study results have rarely been made available for constructive use by North-End residents. Black leaders have realized the value of many studies and have expressed interest in having access to materials about their community. The initial impetus for this list came from Robert Heifitz, Professor of Urban Planning, and Robert Flatley, a graduate student and local community organizer, who recognized the importance of the collection and offered advice during the early stages of collection. Terence Crowley, Director of the Library Research Center, initiated the project by outlining the first steps and by providing staff time.

Mary Vance, Librarian of the City Planning Library, deserves special recognition for having organized the largest single collection of recent material about the social and economic conditions and planning problems of Champaign-Urbana. That collection became the foundation of this bibliography.

SCOPE

This preliminary list of approximately 380 items represents work done primarily since 1955. The types of material include published books, journal articles, research reports, unpublished student reports, theses, correspondence, and leaflets.

The items included were found by searching the main University of Illinois card catalog as well as the catalogs and reserve lists of many departmental libraries. The chain of contacts resulting from interviews with librarians, professors and community leaders provided the bulk of the unpublished, little known but important, material.

It should be noted that City, County and Federal offices in Champaign-Urbana and the Champaign Public Library have not yet been contacted, nor have the bibliographies and references in the cited studies been searched.

It must be emphasized that this is not a final or all inclusive list; more information, sources, and reports are being sought. If this list is to grow in utility, materials newly generated or discovered must continue to be added. If you locate items not included in this preliminary list, please notify the Library Research Center.

ARRANGEMENT

The material included have been arranged in broad subject classifications. Within each subject the material is listed chronologically with the most recent first. The works which were not dated are listed together at the end of each subject area.

Where known, we have included the designation "Student paper" or "Thesis" to better enable the reader to determine the quality. Annotations have been included for some of the items. These were provided by members of Professor Heifitz' 1970 fall studio class. An evaluative statement was included where provided by the students.
