Students in the Premier Camp will be auditioned in voice, brass, woodwinds, piano, bass, and drums on Saturday May 21 or Saturday May 28, 2011. The Premier Camp will focus on individual skill development, small and large ensemble playing, basic music theory and jazz appreciation. This year's highlighted musical genres are New Orleans Jazz and Afro-Cuban Salsa. Students will prepare for a closing concert featuring those styles and gospel music A CD will be made of the concert and given to each student participant.
