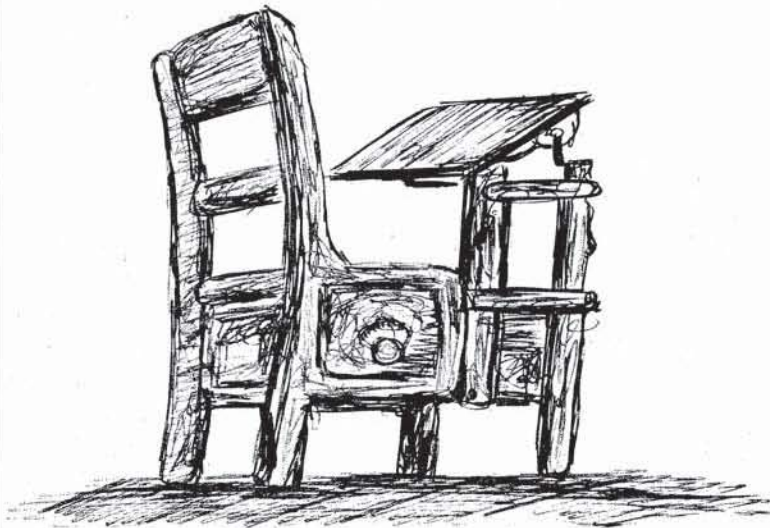
## HATCHET ORATION

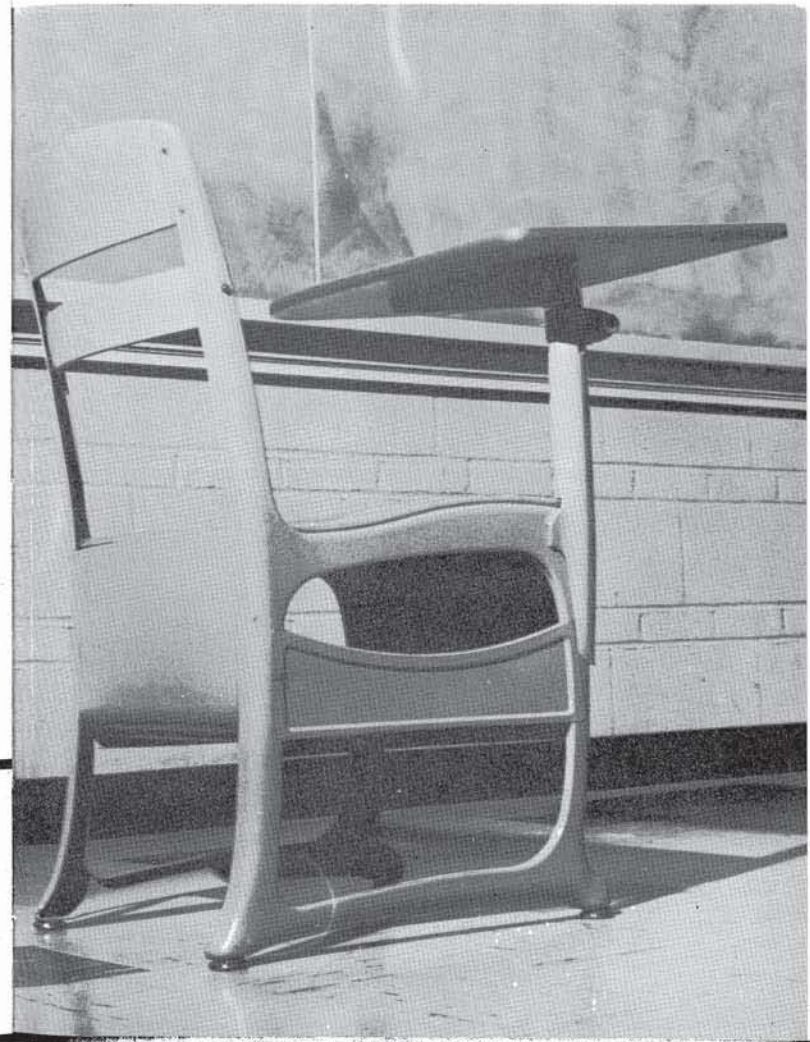
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Modern classrooms with soft green blackboards, fluorescent lighting, streamlined desks, and cherry colored walls all help to make learning a much easier task.
