With only one regular returning from the 1960 team, Coach Macek's linksmen experienced a rebuilding year, winning only one of six dual meets. However, one bright spot in the otherwise dismal season was the outstanding play of Captain Joe Vangness. Joe, the only member of the team with any experience at all, paced the Maroon linksmen all spring. During the season, Joe had several high spots; his top performance was in the twenty-three team Quincy Invitational, where Joe placed third individually, just one stroke behind second, and two behind first. The Maroons took tenth as a team.

Another outstanding performance was turned in by Joe in the four-way meet with New Trier, Quincy, and Joliet; all three of these schools were state powers in golf. Joe was medalist in this one with a seventy-four. Other members of the Maroons were Rick Lynch, who was a junior and second man all year. Golder Wilson, a junior who was a regular, will be lost to the Maroons next year, as he has moved to England. A third junior is Norris Dahlstrom; Norris is also expected to help out next year.

Rounding out the lettermen were two sophomores, Tom Trigger and Mike Braun. The two of them, along with Rick and Norris, give Coach Macek four returning lettermen for next spring. In addition, a fine group of sophomores should give "Big John" the material necessary to build a winning team.

The Maroon netmen, led by Captain Phil Haugaard, were able to win only one dual meet, due chiefly to the fact that they faced some of the toughest competition in the state. The Maroons incurred five of their seven dual meet losses in competition with three of the top ten teams in the state. Five of Captain Haugaard's individual losses were received from three of the four semi-finalists in the state singles championships.

However, in the Conference the Maroons, paced by the doubles teams of Phil Haugaard and Ron Moyer, who reached the semi-finals, and Bill Miller and Bill Thompson, who reached the quarter-finals, were a surprise fourth. Phil Haugaard was first man throughout the season for the Maroons, and he was followed by the ambidextrous Ron Moyer, a junior who is Captain-elect. Ron, who is naturally left-handed, injured his left arm and, while it was in a cast, learned to play right-handed.

Three seniors, Bill Thompson, Bill Miller and Van Brahana, are graduating and will be lost, but next year's net-men will not be lacking in experience. Two juniors, Steve Howard and Jerry Wiley, along with sophomore John Younger will give coach Fred Attebury four letter-men with which to face the 1962 season.

They Had The Pitching...

The 1961 Champaign Baseball Team was coached by Charles Due to their finest record during his stay here, compiling nineteen wins against only four losses. The Maroons opened the season against Clinton and opened it successfully, defeating their rival Maroons, 6-4, behind Rich Callaghan. Two days later, Champaign's other ace, Phil Wilson, took the measure of Villa Grove, shutting them out 12-0. The Maroons then traveled to Springfield where they split a double-header with Feitshans, losing their first game of the season, 8-7.

The Maroons, after trouncing Buckley, lost the first conference game of the season to Mattoon, 5-1. It was the first Conference loss of the season; it was also the last. The Maroons came back to take the second game of the Mattoon double-header, then followed up with wins over Eisenhower, Lincoln, two wins over Danville, and Villa Grove. They then split two with Peoria Central, tied Stephen Decatur in 16 innings, defeated Gilman, and went into the final game of the season leading the Bloomington Raiders by a slim half-game margin.

Bloomington was in town for a double-header and needed to win both games to overtake the Maroons. Both teams were pitching their aces; Bloomington was going with Bobby Spahn, and Charlie Due was resting his hopes on the strong arm of Rich Callaghan. As the game was played at McKinley Field, Bloomington led off. In the top of the first, Callaghan retired the first three Raiders with little difficulty, and the many fans settled down to watch some good, solid baseball.

But the Champaign baseball team had other ideas. They literally took Spahn apart. When he departed it was the bottom of the first; the bases were loaded; there was no one out; and Champaign had pushed across seven runs, putting both the game and the title out of Bloomington's reach. As the game was called after five innings according to the ten run rule, with the score 12-2, Callaghan had only warmed up, so he pitched the second game in addition. The Bloomington pitchers were more generous in the second game, giving up 13 runs, but "The Rock" wasn't. He not only did not give up any runs, but he shut the Raiders out without a hit. When the afternoon's work was finished, the Maroons had accomplished what no Champaign baseball team had been able to do for 21 years.

Then the Maroons moved into state play. They swept through the regional, beating Danville for the third time during the season, 12-2, and squeaking by Paris, 4-3.

Then came the sectional. In another "squeaker," CHS defeated Octavia 3-2. In the final game of the sectional, Champaign closed out its season, bowing to Eisenhower, 1-0, as Rich Callaghan was handed his third loss of the season to go with 10 wins.

But if Callaghan was the leader on the mound, Val Bush was even more so at the plate. Val led the Maroons in almost every department: he was the leading hitter with a .454 average. He had the most hits, 59; the most doubles, 8; the most home runs, 2; and the most stolen bases, 26. In two departments, triples and runs batted in, Val yielded to Callaghan. In addition to his offensive leadership, Val led the team on defense, combining with shortstop Phil Wilson to form the best keystone combination Champaign has had for quite a few years.

As a team, the Maroons had a phenomenal .335 batting average for the season, as compared to a miserable .151 for the combined opposition's average. On offense, the Maroons did not merely rely on hitting; as their 98 stolen bases would indicate, they ran and ran well. At the season's end, Coach Due bade a fond farewell to seniors Val Bush, Rich Callaghan, and Phil Wilson, all of whom had been with him for three of his four years here. Bush's contributions have already been enumerated; and Callaghan and Wilson, who both hit well over .300, combined to pitch 16 of Champaign's 19 victories. Also departing were the Peterson twins, George and Mike, who were regulars all year and two of the team's leading hitters. Although his pitching staff was depleted by graduation, Coach Due is expecting help from seniors Chuck Peabody and Carl Punkay, and from transfer Larry Bundy.

At the season's end, varsity letters were awarded to seniors Val Bush, Phil Wilson, Rich Callaghan, George Peterson, and Mike Peterson; juniors Larry Mennenga, Bob Waller, Carl Punkay, and Barry Moore; sophomores Fred Klemm and Don Langhoff; and Manager John Welch.

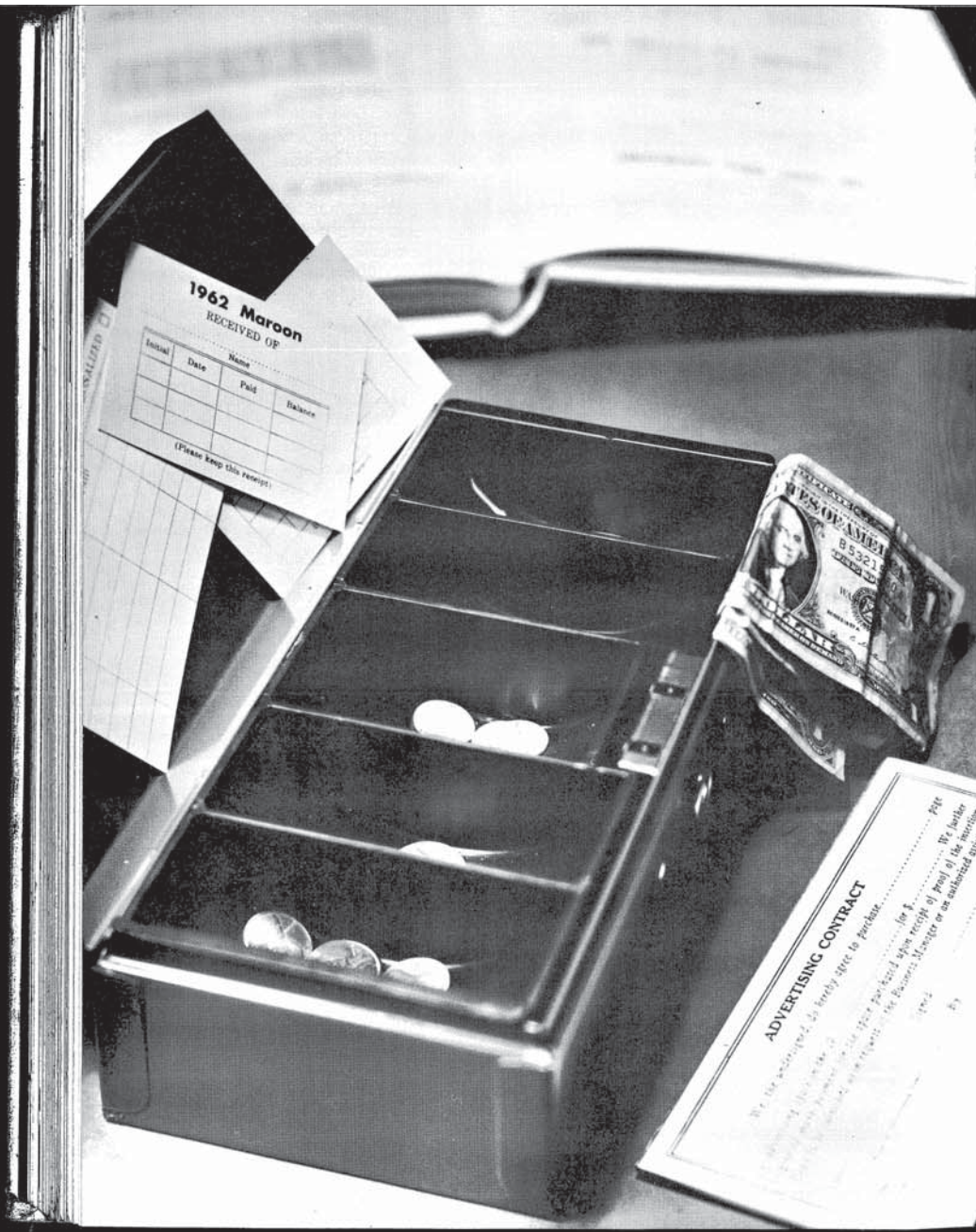
