3. You must pick at least 3 different items from the 5 offered. (However 2 different fruits or 2 different vegetables will count.)

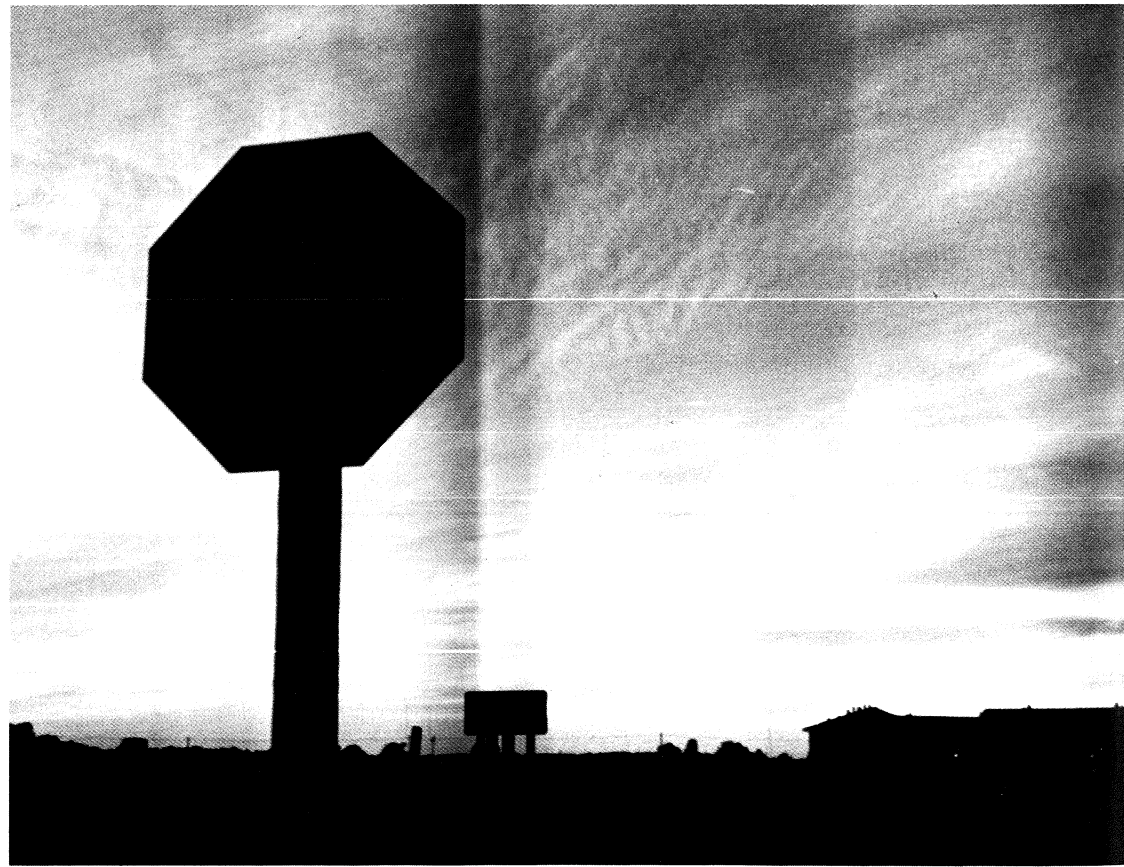
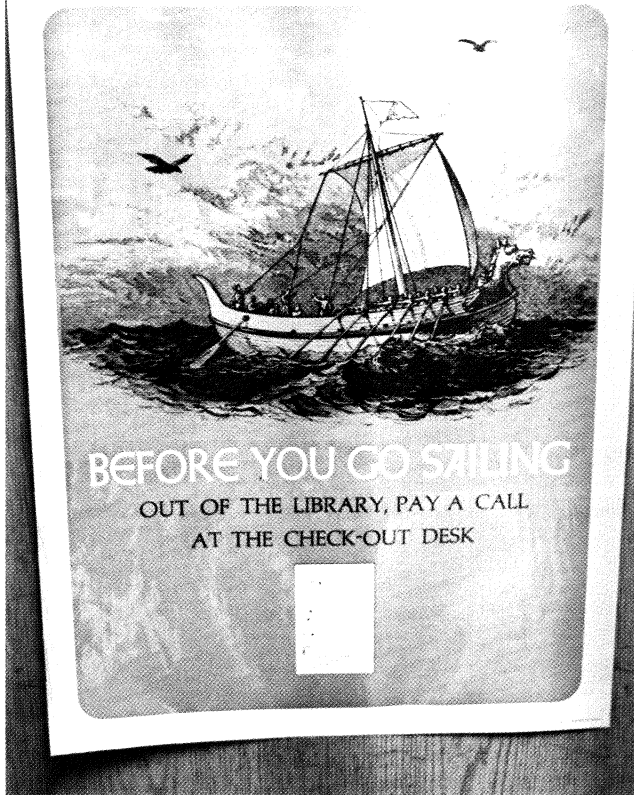
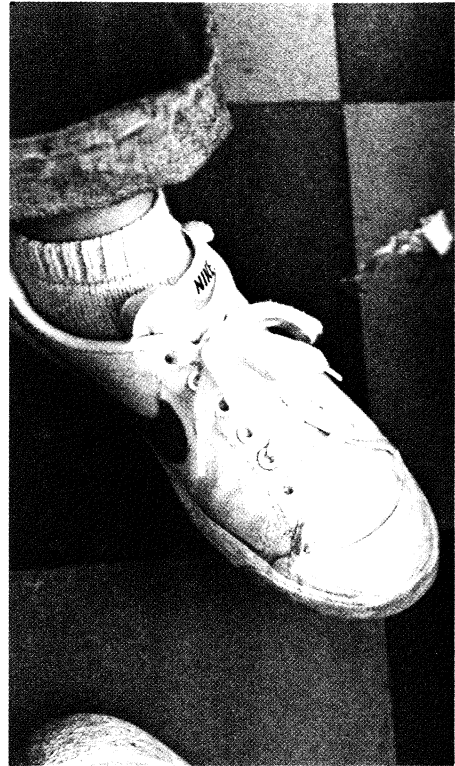

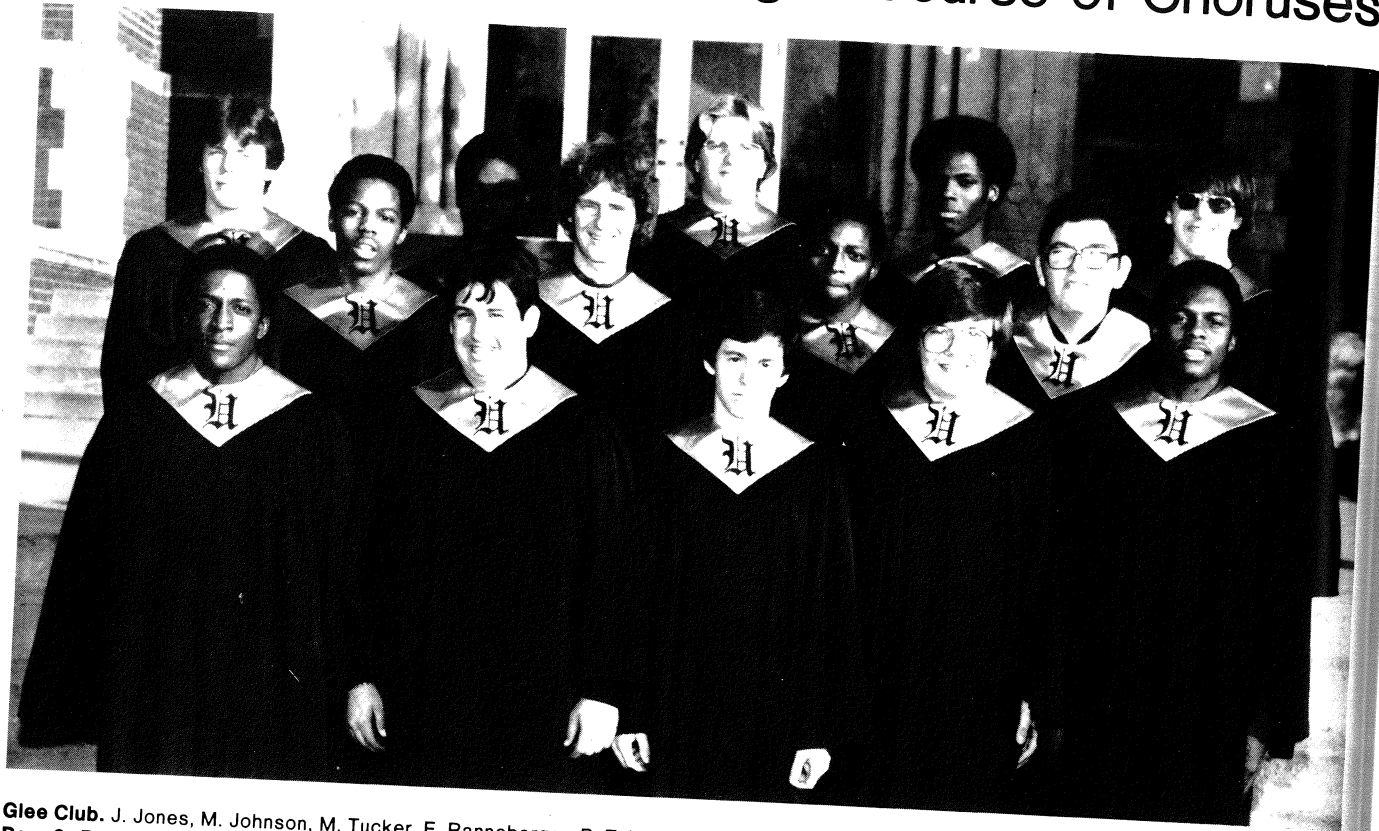

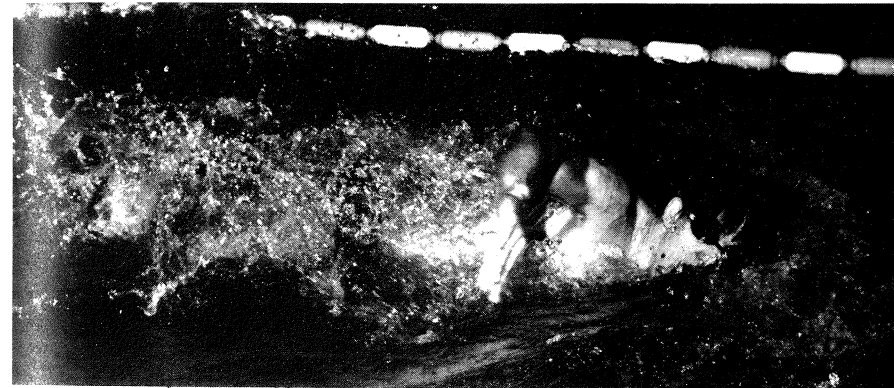

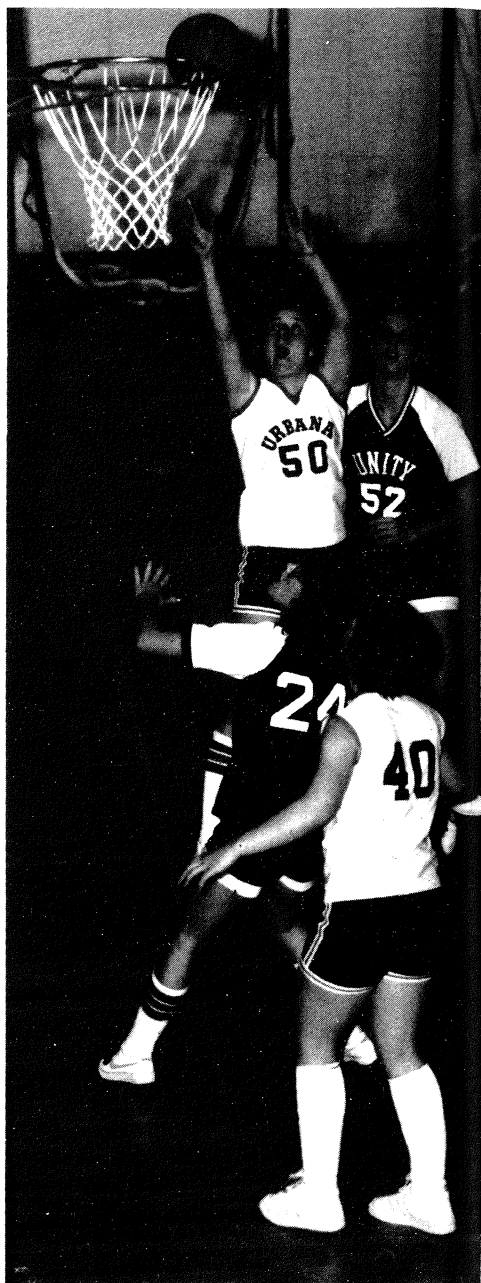

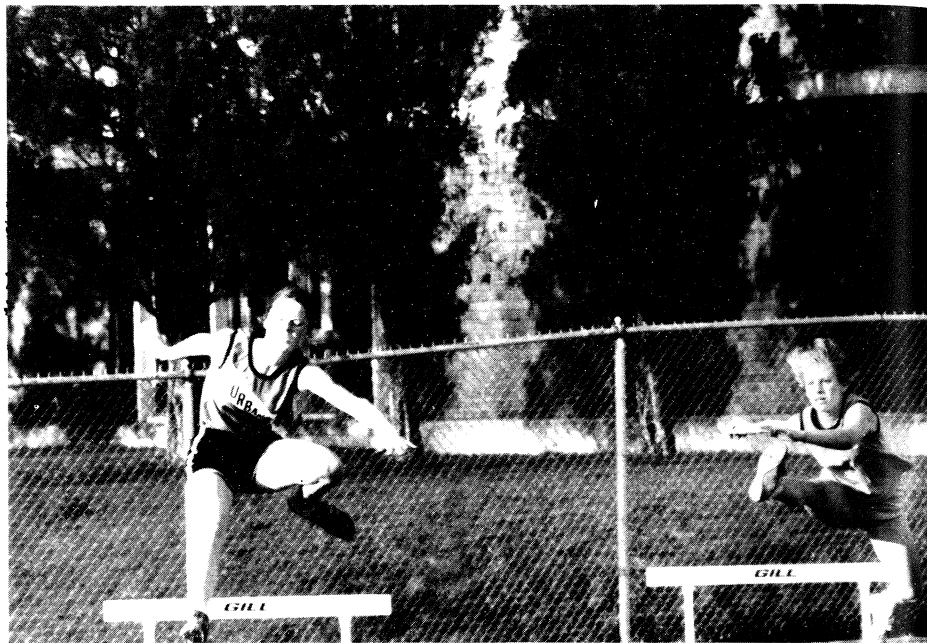

Principal Robertson Leaves Urbana



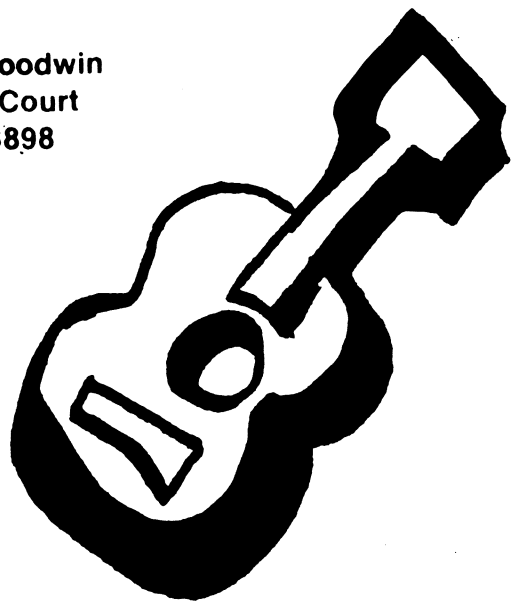
