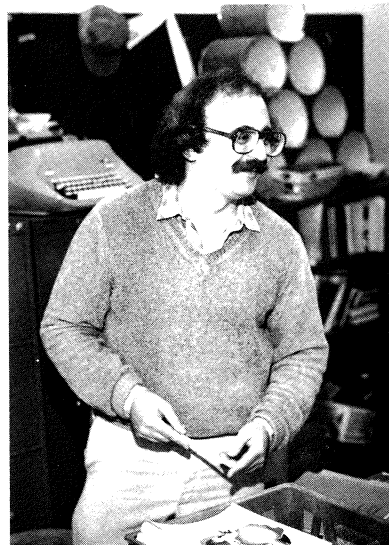
Tigers tackle traditional programs to complete the 26 credit graduation requirement. Some courses and programs are not so traditional and allow students unusual opportunities to pursue particular interests and needs. Various vocational programs and classes allow students to learn to earn. A House Construction class compliments Industrial Arts Ed. The Executive High School Internship Program, now in its second year, permits some students to explore professional career interests by working for a semester in that field. Pathfinders learn wilderness survival skills and trek West for practical experience. Sea Explorers venture to the Florida Keys for study. PUPS provides students with interest in child development a chance to work with pre-kindergartners and parents. Medical Careers classes add dimension for other students. A course in theater lighting and one in Life Studies serve others. Cultural differences are bridged in E.S.L. and Youth for Understanding programs. Old or new, offerings are varied and plentiful.

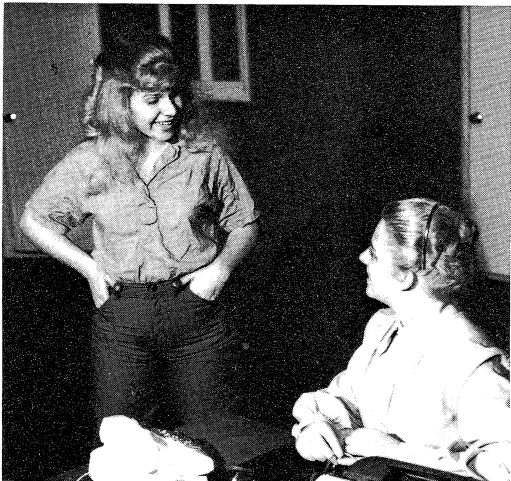
WUHS broadcasts tiger pride

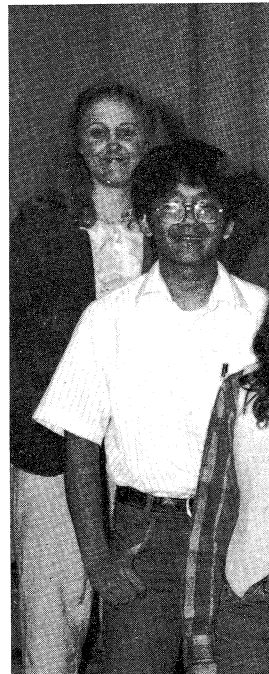
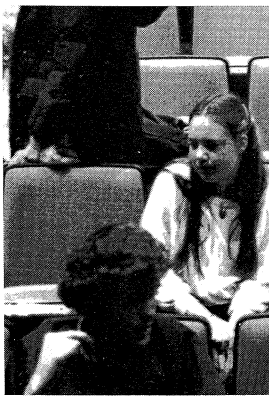
Speech is the thing

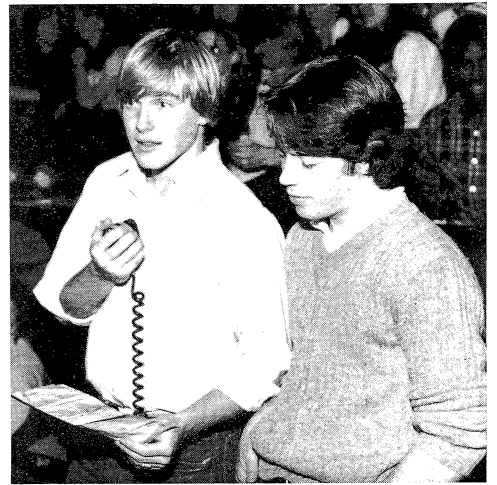
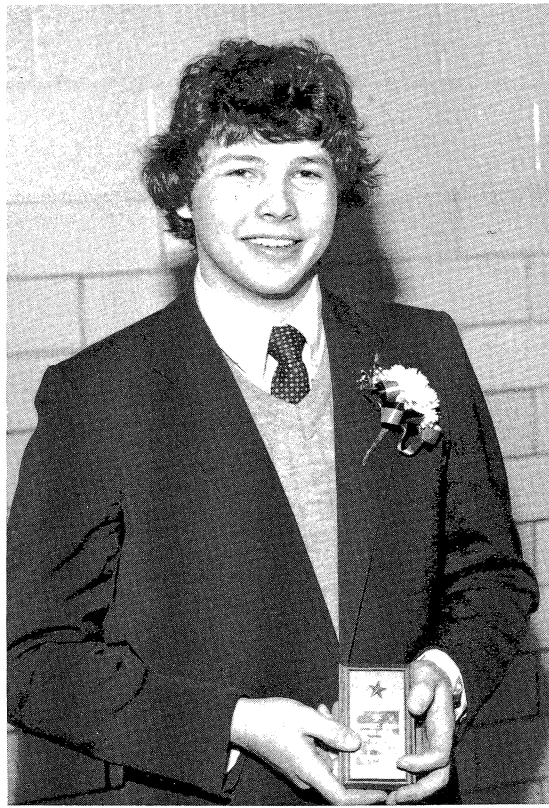




Rosemary Award — Outstanding Senior
