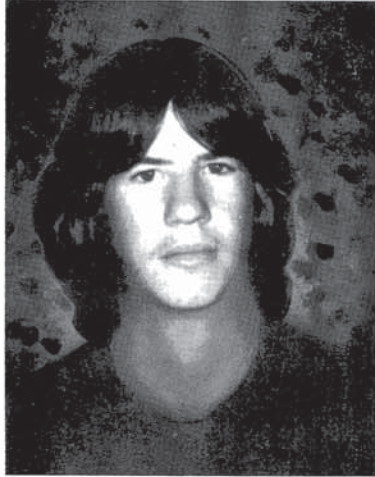


IN MEMORY OF GREG PANKAU
