<u>Important Dates for the Primary Election – March 20, 2012</u>

Now until February 21 – Deputy Registrars can register people to vote and/or change name/address for those already registered. You can also go to the Brookens Building (1776 E. Washington, Urbana) or go on-line at champaigncountyclerk.org.*

<u>February 9 – February 26</u> – **In-person Absentee Voting** – if you are <u>already a registered voter</u> at your current address, you may vote during this time at the Brookens Building (1776 E Washington, U.) or request an official ballot to be sent to you by mail, by calling the County Clerk's office at 217-384-3724. If sent by mail, it must be **returned postmarked no later than Monday, March 19**.*

<u>February 22 – March 13</u> – Grace Period Voting at the Brookens Building (1776 E. Washington, U.) for those who need to register to vote and/or change their name or address. You will register to vote and will be mailed a ballot which must be returned postmarked no later than midnight on Monday, March 19.*

<u>February 27 – March 15</u> – Early Voting at the Brookens Building (1776 E. Washington, U) if you are already a registered voter at your current address.*

<u>March 17** – March 19</u> – **In-person Absentee Voting** at the Brookens Building (1776 E. Washington, U.) if you are <u>already a registered voter</u> at your **current address.***

<u>March 20 – October 10</u> – Voter Registration for those who will 18 years old on or before the November 6 General Election, and/or need to change their name/address AND will be a permanent resident in their precinct at least 30 days before the November 6 General Election.
